- ❖ Display the enclosed posters throughout your church, education buildings, etc.

ON THE DAY THE OFFERING IS COLLECTED:

- ❖ Place the insert into your bulletin on the day of the offering.
- ❖ Read the enclosed Mission Moment on the day of the offering.
- ❖ Donations are tax-deductible and checks can be made out to Black Mountain Home.

AFTER THE OFFERING IS COLLECTED:

- ❖ Cash donations and checks for Black Mountain Home made out to your church should be deposited in your account, then one church check written for the total amount.
